Dear Parents,

Our annual Craft Show is scheduled for October, Friday 10th, Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th. Each year the boys are asked to donate items to the concession area. Listed below are the drink donations requested of **each** player per grade level as well as **SWEET SHOP** donations.

SENIORS: Two cases ea. (48ct) DASANI WATER

JUNIORS: Two cases ea. DR, PEPPER

SOPHOMORES: Two cases ea. (48ct) COKE (Players A-M) DIET COKE (Players N-Z)

FRESHMEN: One case (24 ct. - 20 oz.) POWERADE (multi colored)

*Note ... any excess drink donations will be sold at Warrior Café during baseball games

THE SWEET SHOP is a huge part of our Craft Show! Many customers return each year to get their home baked goodies. If you haven't seen it.....well, just think of the ultimate bake sale on steroids!

Each player family is asked to bake AT LEAST one of the following:

- 3-4 dozen cookies, treats or brownies
- Please wrap 2 Large cookies per bag,
- 3 Medium cookies per bag, or 4 Small cookies per bag
- 2 whole pies - wrapped separately
- 1 large cake

Your items must be home baked, individually wrapped tight as noted above, in clear bags so the items can be seen. Each bag must be marked with a description of the item and noted WITH or WITHOUT nuts.

Presentation helps sell, so get crafty!! Customers love to see fall and holiday decorative bags, ribbons, plates, etc. The Health Department will not allow us to accept anything that needs refrigeration, so please keep this in mind.

Your baked, wrapped and labeled items and drinks will need to be checked in with our volunteer rep at the check in table when you come in to help on Friday, October 10th at 5:45pm. Your son's name will be checked off once your items are received and you will be directed where to deliver your donated items and where you will be assigned to work move-in.

SPECIAL NOTE: Each year, we are overloaded with chocolate chip cookies and brownies. If you plan to make these, please get creative, and make them look extraordinary.

NOTE Players will be assigned to designated areas to work by Brendan Marsh & Tonya
Levitt... Coach may also assign as well.. Make sure they check-in with us every day, every
shift.. Parent volunteers will also check in w/Brendan Marsh @ check-in to know where you
signed up and duties and so we know the area is covered.

In baseball class, each boy will be assigned an additional time to work the Craft Show.
Due to UIL rules, the boys cannot be assigned to work on Sunday, Oct. 12th WE, AS
PARENTS, will be responsible for assisting vendors, having your player at show during
the day, and helping to move crafters out of the school & clean up. (Remember – we as
parents have our boys help Sunday).
